



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Travel
 - a. Volunteers are responsible for arranging and financing their mode of travel to and from Cartagena.
 - b. Volunteers are responsible for arranging and paying for transportation to and from project sites during the duration of their time with Domino Volunteers.
 - c. Volunteer will be picked-up and dropped-off once upon arrival and once upon departure from Rafael Nunez International Airport (at the beginning and end of their volunteer time).
 - d. Volunteers are responsible for all passport and visa related matters and expenses and/or any other necessary travel and medical documents or costs needed to enter and leave Colombia.

2. Insurance and Medical
 - a. All volunteers are required to select and pay for a medical insurance plan that covers them for the duration of their time with Domino Volunteers. Volunteers may also choose to purchase additional travel insurance as they deem fit. It is up to the volunteer to determine the type, extent and provider of insurance. Domino Volunteers does not carry or provide any type of insurance whatsoever for any volunteer. Domino Volunteers and associated persons are not responsible for any actions, omissions or cancelations on the part of medical, travel or another type of insurance provider.
 - b. Domino Volunteers, project placements and associated persons are not responsible or liable for any medical or personal costs, injuries or accidents incurred by a volunteer or any third party.
 - c. Domino Volunteers, associated persons and project placements will act in their best judgment on the volunteer's behalf. Volunteers release and discharge Domino Volunteers, their project placement and all associated administrators, staff and persons from any claim which arises or may arise on account of treatment or service rendered by such entities.
 - d. Domino Volunteers will not administer any medications to volunteers. Volunteers requiring medicine will need to bring it with them or purchase it in Cartagena themselves.

3. Drug and Alcohol
 - a. Drug possession or use by the volunteer, unless prescribed by a medical professional, is prohibited during the duration of a volunteer's time with Domino Volunteers.
 - b. When at his/her project placement or doing volunteer-related activities, it is prohibited for a volunteer to drink alcohol. If Domino Volunteers feels that alcohol is hindering a volunteer's success at his/her project, the volunteer can be removed from the Domino Volunteers program with no refund.

4. Meals & Accommodation
 - a. Two meals a day, breakfast and lunch, will be provided to volunteers. Domino Volunteers will work to accommodate volunteers with special food needs and allergies. Volunteers will not be reimbursed for meals provided by Domino Volunteers or their projects, missed meals or if they chose to eat somewhere else.
 - b. All persons who are not associated with Domino Volunteers must be pre-approved by Domino Volunteers and/or host-families to enter the volunteer's accommodation. Only the volunteer him/herself can sleep in the accommodation provided, unless otherwise approved by Domino Volunteers.
 - c. Domino Volunteers will provide volunteers with accommodation for the duration of the volunteer's time with the program. If a volunteer sleeps elsewhere, he/she agrees to inform Domino Volunteers staff and have them confirm beforehand. If the volunteer wishes to travel outside of Cartagena, he/she must tell Domino Volunteers beforehand, have his/her travel approved and be in communication with Domino Volunteers.

5. Use of Photos, Videos and Feedback
 - a. Volunteers give Domino Volunteers the right, title, interest, and usage of photos, videos and feedback of the volunteer, such as for promotional purposes in brochures or websites.

6. Telephones
 - a. Volunteers will be provided a cell phone, SIM card and phone credit to make and receive phone calls in cases of emergency. Volunteers must remain with this phone and credit at all times in order to be able to receive and make calls in an emergency situation.
 - b. Should the volunteer lose, break or damage the phone and/or SIM card, he/she is responsible for reimbursing Domino Volunteers for its cost.
 - c. Phones and SIM cards are to be returned to Domino Volunteers when a volunteer finishes his/her time as a volunteer.

7. Deposit and Program Fees
 - a. A volunteer must pay a \$100 USD deposit fee via PayPal so that Domino Volunteers can hold his/her spot and begin to make necessary arrangements and placements.
 - b. The program fee is determined by the number of weeks a volunteer chooses to stay with Domino Volunteers. Volunteers pay the program fee before or immediately when starting with Domino Volunteers in Cartagena. Payments can be made via PayPal, transfers or cash (in US Dollars or Colombian Pesos).

8. Change of Date or Cancellation
 - a. Cancellation prior to arrival on part of the volunteer must be in emailed to dominovolunteers@gmail.com and confirmed by Domino Volunteers. The \$100 deposit fee is nonrefundable.
 - b. After the start date with Domino Volunteers, a volunteer who is removed from or voluntarily leaves the Domino Volunteers program before the scheduled end date will not receive any refund.

- c. Domino Volunteers has the right to change or cancel program dates with the safety and best interests of the volunteers and/or Colombian locals in mind. If Domino Volunteers is responsible for a program's date change or cancelation after a volunteer has started volunteering in Cartagena, Domino Volunteers will reimburse the program fee for the remaining amount of time (the deposit fee is nonrefundable).

I understand that Domino Volunteers does not assume responsibility or obligation to provide financial or other assistance to me including but not limited to medical, health and/or insurance. I agree to compensate all harm, loss or liability that Domino Volunteers, its staff, its administrators, other volunteers, projects and their staff, or any other persons incur in connection to me. I agree to abide by all laws of Colombia in addition to rules and regulations set by Domino Volunteers and projects where I am a volunteer. I accept that Domino Volunteers and its staff are not liable for any actions or omissions of projects, foundations, organizations, companies, individuals, or any third party. I understand that Domino Volunteers provides services to volunteers such as food, accommodation, transportation, and activities and accepts no responsibility, in part or whole, for loss, damage, or injury to persons or property caused to me or others in association with such services. I will not expose individuals that I come into contact with to abuse, neglect or violence and furthermore will treat them with consideration and respect. I realize that Domino Volunteers can remove me from a project or its program at any time, for any reason and with no refund if it so chooses. Finally, all details in my "Volunteer Inscription Form" are correct. I am physically, mentally and emotionally healthy and able and have no preexisting conditions unknown to Domino Volunteers.
